A SOURCE OF HELPFUL LOCAL INFORMATION

CORONAVIRUS - COMMUNITY ACTION IN SAINTFIELD

Martyn Todd writes, "As Chair of a community group in Saintfield I have been keeping in touch with local councillors and the Council officer responsible for the Rowallane District Electoral Area (DEA). From these contacts I have gathered that NMD Council will be carrying out a public information campaign aimed at ensuring that any vulnerable or isolated person who does not have family members or neighbours to help them still receives the help they need. This help may be just a daily phone call for a chat, errands, run for food or medication or a dog exercised.

The current plan, as I am advised, is that the Council information will name each DEA officer and give their phone number. For Rowallane DEA, this is Ellen Brennan. Ellen has

the name of a community volunteer for each town in the Rowallane DEA. If she receives a request for help from a person in Saintfield, she will pass that person's number on to me. Our local councillor, Kathy Owen has given me a list of over a dozen people who have volunteered to help vulnerable or isolated people, whether by phoning them for a chat or doing some shopping for them. She has given this list to me so that, when Ellen passes on a request for help. I can go down this list of volunteers until I find someone able to take on the

I know that most vulnerable or isolated people in Saintfield will already have a family member or good neighbour who will look after them. I also know that there are many people self-isolating at home who are

willing to help where they can. The SDA motto is "Saintfield People Working for Saintfield People". In these difficult times helping those who need it brings this motto to life. Together we can ensure that no one in and around Saintfield goes without the help they need."
